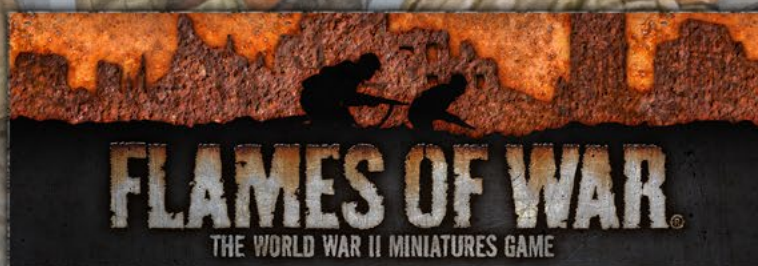
ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

You may field a Panzerjäger I Tank-hunter Platoon as an additional Anti-tank Support Box in an *Eastern Front* German Force.

You may field a Panhard 178 Scout Troop instead of a Sd Kfz 221 & 222 Light Scout Troop in a Reconnaissance Support Box in an *Eastern Front* German Force.

PANZERJÄGER I TANK-HUNTER PLATOON



- 4x Panzerjäger I (4.7cm) **6 POINTS**
- 3x Panzerjäger I (4.7cm) **4 POINTS**
- 2x Panzerjäger I (4.7cm) **3 POINTS**

Germany entered 1942 with the light Panzerjäger I as its only self-propelled tank-hunter. The independent divisional tank-hunter battalions (*Panzerjäger-Abteilungen*) started receiving the far more powerful Marder II and III tank-hunters only from the middle of 1942, ready for the advance to Stalingrad.

These independent anti-tank battalions were typically attached to higher-level army groups or corps rather than being permanent parts of a single division, though they frequently supported specific infantry and panzer divisions in combat.

PANHARD 178 ARMoured CAR COMPANY

German army extensively used the French-built Panhard 178 armoured car, in particular it was used by reconnaissance battalions of the 7th and 20th Panzer Divisions.

Your Force includes one Panhard 178(f) Armoured Car Company, which is a Formation containing:

- 1 HQ Unit of 1x Panhard 178 (25mm) armoured car from (MG275) for 1 point.
- 2-8 Panhard 178 Scout Troop (MG275)
- 1-3 Sd Kfz 231 Heavy Scout Troop (MG224)
- 0-1 Panzergrenadier Platoon (MG210)
- 0-1 3.7cm Tank-hunter Platoon (MG225) or 5cm Tank-Hunter Platoon (MG226)

The French Panhard 178 armoured car, designated as the *Panzerspähwagen P204(f)* in German service, proved well-suited to German tactics, being considered fast and reliable.

At least 190 Panhards, most of them brand-new, were issued to German reconnaissance units for use in Operation Barbarossa in 1941. Thirty Panhards were listed as still in use on the Eastern Front by 31 May 1943.
